Institute of Technology, Coimbatore organized a One Day Seminar on “Utilization of E-waste as Alternative Construction Materials” (Under the aegis of ENDB). The seminar aimed to address critical environmental challenges and promote sustainable construction practices.

The seminar was inaugurated by Er Prasanth Omanakuttan, Founder and CEO, M/s Green Era Recycler, Coimbatore. The session was presided over by Dr G Madhan Mohan, Honorary Secretary, IEI Coimbatore Local Centre, while Dr S U Prabha, Principal, Dr. N.G.P. Institute of Technology delivered the felicitation address. Dr K Murali, Professor and Head, Department of Civil Engineering, Dr. N.G.P. Institute of Technology shared information about the seminar with the audience. In the first lecture, Er Prasanth Omanakuttan delivered a talk titled “E-Waste: Threat to Society” addressing the growing issue of e-waste. The All India Seminar on “Green Technology for Sustainable Food Production and Processing” (Under the aegis of AGDB) was organized by The Institution of Engineers (India), Coimbatore Local Centre in partnership with Department of Food Technology, Hindusthan College of Engineering and Technology, Coimbatore, during October 24-25, 2024.

On the first day, the seminar commenced with an inaugural session. Dr G Jeevarathinam, Associate Professor and Head, Dept of Food Technology, HICET provided an overview of the seminar. 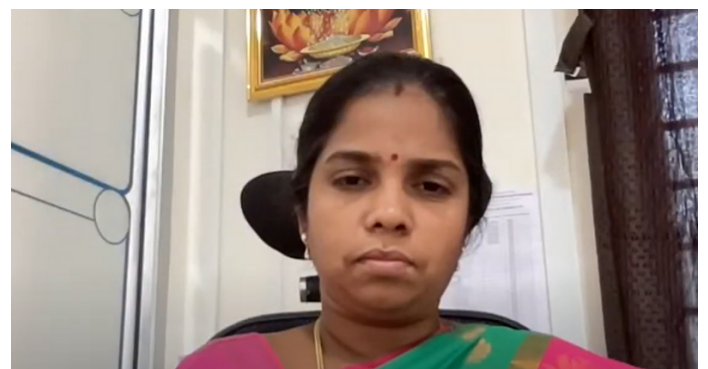
Dr T Beni, Assistant Professor, School of Computer Science and Engineering, Vellore Institute of Technology, Chennai shared views
